It is a challenge, it is a commitment, and we are committed with your faith, in our new purpose.

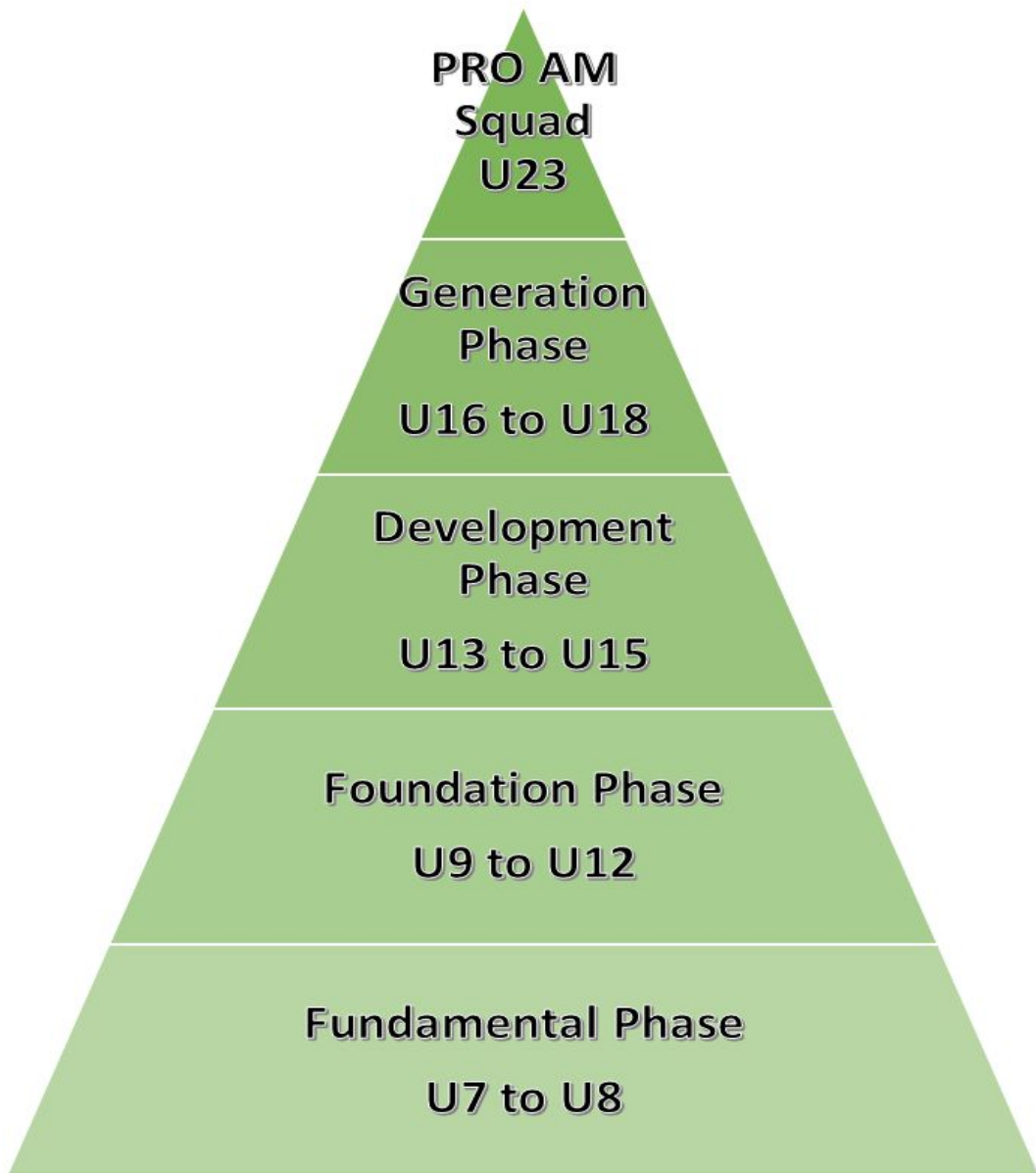

# Program Information

## Indoor 2021 -2022 Program Details

- Training Season runs from October 18, 2021 to April 8, 2021. Scheduled Breaks are:
  - December 18 through January 7
  - March 18 through April 3
- We are thrilled to be able to provide most training sessions on turf fields
- Early start times for turf sessions and training free weekends (other than scheduled games)
- A development focused program building onto the Pro Pathway for Soccer
- For players U7 – Pro Amateur
- Phase Managers with a Coach Education program that will be implemented in all phases
- Age-appropriate technical curriculum and high-level technical plan
- All training sessions at the Calgary West Soccer Centre, Viper Dome , Shouldice (January 2022 onward) and other NW indoor facilities.
- Full uniform for practices and games will be purchased individually by members at our retail partner and mandatory for every training and game event on field.



# National Youth Club Licence

In September 2020, after a rigorous review process, Canada Soccer announced that Calgary West Soccer Club was granted the National Youth Club Licence (NYCL), the highest amateur youth club designation in the Canada Soccer Club Licensing Program.

The Canada Soccer National Youth Club License recognizes the highest achieving organizations from across Canada and rewards them with the Canada Soccer Approved Youth Soccer Club endorsement. Organizations achieving this license display characteristics and demonstrate behaviours aligned with the highest expectations of governance, administration, infrastructure, and technical, support their PTSO and Canada Soccer Pathways and participate in the highest level of competition in Canada; the Canada Soccer Player Development Program.

The rollout for the AYSL 2007 groups will begin September 2021 with a combine on September 11th and 18th in Calgary. Watch for a communication and registration information from CMSA.

Players will begin by registering for the CMSA program, and when placed on an AYSL roster there will be additional fees due to cover the extra league fees for the program.

Alberta Soccer will launch one age group annually until all ages are represented in 2023. Each year, a new U14 group will be introduced to the league as the previous U14 group advances to the next age category.





# Registration

**Opens September 1, 2021 and closes on September 22, 2021**

Please note: CMSA players who have not paid their fees (registration/academy/head coach) will be deregistered with CMSA by December 1 for indoor. Early bird registration fees take place Sept 1, 2021 - September 14, 2021. All registrations not paid by then will have a late fee of \$25 charged. Late fees take effect on September 15, 2021.

## **Credit card or cheque:**

Credit card payments will be charged a 2.75% surcharge.

Cheques are accepted. NSF cheques will have a charge of \$25

**CWSC Membership:** purchase required once per season per family in order to register at a cost of \$25

# Evaluations

## Evaluation Process - Player Placement

We had a great opportunity this summer to have our technical team work closely with our players to get to know them much closer and better. This will help us to establish, what we believe would be the best environment for each player, to support her/his further development.

Our club has always been known for providing opportunities to all players regardless of their age and stage of development, level of maturity and relative age effect. We assure you, that all decision will be made after a deep consideration based on all the information below, between club Phase Managers.

1. Player registers for the indoor season. This will provide Phase Managers with information about the number of players in all age groups.
2. The Director of Soccer, alongside Phase Managers will make the final decision on player placement based on this information:

### Returning Players

- Previous participation in a team from last CMSA season
- Performances during Return to Play programs this summer
- Information from the team coaches (if applicable)
- Conversation with other Phase Managers, who had the chance to work with a player

### New Players

- Information about their last CMSA season they have participated at (age group and Tier level)
- Conditions of our teams and their needs
- Conversation with the players, their desires and history
- Opportunities to attend sessions through the fall season



## Equipment/Uniform Requirements

Players in the **U7/U8/U9** age groups will be provided with a game shirt. Training kits will be available for purchase and mandatory for all training sessions. Watch for details about purchasing from Kicks Sporting Goods.

Players in **U10 to U19** will be required to purchase CWSC Game/Training Kits from Kicks Sporting Goods. Certain tiers will be required to purchase up to 3 kits. The kits purchased will be at a reasonable cost and be usable for 4 seasons, or until the player outgrows it.

Shin-guards, and appropriate footwear are required for all ages.

All additional Club wear is available for purchase year-round from KICKS Sporting Goods
